Project Description:

The aim of our project is to arrange a Training Course (around 5 days in Italy) between operators, tutors, leaders and teachers of young people in order to exchange their expertise, good practice, experience and diverse techniques how to create an intercultural dialoge between young people from different etnical backgrounds. In particular in a specific area of Perugia we have the problem of a society that is divided into two different parts: the Italians and the immigrants. Some episodes of violence and intollerance happended in the last months. The local population is scared. They generalize the situation without seeing how the social tensions can be solved. Instead of taking advantage of the possibility to honor the diversity and learn from each other, there is a boarder, made from skepsis, prejudgement and ignorance. The local administration is expecting some projects and proposals from associations and centers that are working in the social field to create a net as soon as possible. This is the context in which we create this TRAINING COURSE to give an intercultural impulse for this net. The title of our project, "Colourful Puzzleworld", is a metaphora: all over the world there are different nations and they are diverse like peaces of a puzzle. On the first sight it seems that they don't fit together, but if you look closer, if you have patience and motivation, you discover that all of them together can create a harmonic colourful picture. In our project we want to do a training with operators working in the youth sector. We will involve 5 people from each country (3 plus Italy), in order to take advantage of the environments that offer a cultural diversity. Each participant is invited to talk about his experiences, explain and confront, in a pratical way, the problems of their country/city/area and share his practices and knowledge. In particular, we want to give to all the participants new practical instruments to work on intercultural level in their own city. We hope to achieve a better awareness of young people, focusing the goal that diversity should be a motivation to get united instead of being an excuse for violence and discrimination. We want also to organized, during these 5 days of training course, some moments in which the participants will be in contact with the local context (young people, citizens, local institutions, foreigners, ecc.) to make visible and to share what we discuss and

discover all together about the themes. This will be useful to involve, on different levels of this project, all the people that live these kind of situations only like "problems", to create with them new points of view and new ideas to create a good feeling, new european projects with "Youth in Action" Programme and a positive collaboration between them and people from other cultures that live now in the city.

The training course Never Ending Stories will be settled in Orvieto, will be managed in cooperation with the local association Atremide and is 7 days long. The aim of it is to focus on the analysis of the youth social problems, in particular those affecting the outskirts of the biggest European cities. We would like to involve the youngsters of the outskirts and the social workers who work in the Youth Centres and in the youth field coming from Rome, Tallin, Bucarest, Ankara, Sofia, Madrid and Dublin. We want to analyse the daily conflicts that can be found in these big cities, the conflicts among youngsters of different backgrounds, religions and ethnic groups; our aim is to train the youngsters making them more sensitive and respectful about the differences and to train the social workers who are going to deal with these youngsters in their daily activities.
